13 ference reports relating to access to health care, which  
14 may include legislation preventing reductions in funding  
15 for Medicaid that could lead to benefit cuts, coverage loss,  
16 or slashed provider payments, by the amounts provided  
17 in such legislation for those purposes, provided that such  
18 legislation would not increase the deficit over the period  
19 of the total of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.
